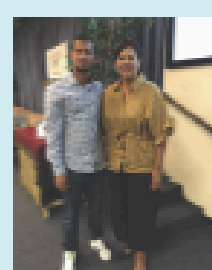
Call to Action

We've ended the largest government shutdown in the US history. However, congress has a deadline on February 15 to make a negotiation to prevent another shutdown. Congress needs to hear from people of faith that welcomes immigrants, upholds their human dignity, and does not accept further border enforcement!

1. **Schedule a congressional visit in your district this week.** If you are willing to do so, please let us know so we can direct others in your district to join!
2. Call your congress representative and use this script:

"My name is _____ and I'm a member of [name of faith community] in your District. As the negotiations to prevent another government shutdown continues, I call on you to reject any proposal for funding the border wall, enforcement, or detention of refugees seeking asylum. I urge you to support an appropriations bill that includes resources for humanitarian needs, case management for those in detention, more immigration judges in courts at the border, and ending intentional delays."

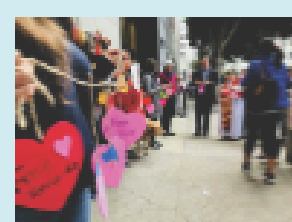

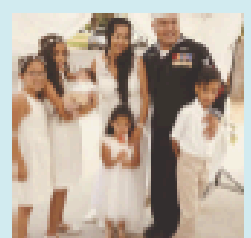
